

IMPERIAL SESSION 2024

Doing More in 24

On Friday 28 June 2024 Ill Sir Volker Deussen, Lady Kerstin, Ill Sir Paul M. Curran, Lady Marlene, Ill Sir Frank Ullmann, Lady Katja, Noble Anthony Ward and Lady Toshia made their way to Reno, Nevada for the 150th Imperial Session. Once arriving in Reno they met up Ill Sir Charsten Wienbreyer, Ill Sir Ward Williamson and Lady Beate, Most Worshipful (Noble) Catalin Tohaneanu, Grand Master of Romania and Lady Aruna, Most Worshipful (Noble) Daniel Jap Lim, Past Grand Master American Canadian Grand Lodge, and Lady Meltem, Sovereign Grand Commander of the Scottish Rite for Romania (Noble) Alecu Racoviceanu, Grand Treasurer of The National Grand Lodge of Romania RW (Noble) Stelian Tipa, Noble Jonny Henke and Lady Imme, Noble Razvan Buzatu, Noble Cristian Mirica and his son Aiden and daughter Maria. This was the biggest contingent of the Emirat Shrine family ever to attend an Imperial session.

On Saturday was registration and Ill Volker Deussen, Ill Paul M. Curran and Noble Anthony Ward had to be at a hearing at 1045 for call item 15, which was to have Emirat have exclusive jurisdiction over the Middle East. During the hearing it was ruled the item for the call was out of order because the Middle East is not defined and therefore cannot be claimed. During the process it was decided that we could claim the UAE and Saudi Arabia as they were defined and have concurrent jurisdiction with Lubnan Temple in Lebanon. When call item number 15 was called for by the Imperial Potentate, on Tuesday day 3 of the Imperial Session, Noble Anthony Ward called for the adoption of item 15, but had an amendment to it, which is stated above, it was passed by majority vote, so Emirat now has concurrent jurisdiction with Lubnan Shriners over the UAE and Saudi Arabia.



On Sunday morning was the Annual Meeting of the Shrine Recorders Association, the oldest association in the Shrine. During the Annual Meeting Ill Paul M. Curran was elected as the First Vice President of the Shrine Recorders Association.


On Tuesday right after the Hall of Fame Luncheon Ill Sir Volker Deussen received the Platinum Award for Membership for the year 2023.

This is the first year for that Platinum Award has been awarded by Shriners International and Emirat Shrine is honored to have received it. Emirat has previously won the Gold Membership Award in 2011, 2013, 2014, 2016, 2018, 2019, 2021 and 2022.

Also on Tuesday after all the Membership Awards were handed out, they conducted the vote of the Board of Trustee to serve a three year term. Because their where 5 running for the 2 positions we had to use a paper ballot, which takes a long time as Colorado and lowa vote. After about an hour of counting ballots the winners were announced, the winners were Ill Sir Ricky Arrocha elected to serve his second three year term and Imperial Sir Kenneth "Kenny" Carven elected to serve his first three year term. Because of Trustee Dr. Ken Guidera resignation, their needed to be a special election to fill the remaining 2 years on his term. Ill Sir Ronald L. "Ron" Capps won by majority vote and will serve the next two years. Next item on the agenda was the election of a new Chairman of the Board of Trustees as Imperial Sir Jerry Gant was retiring after many years of service to Shriners International and Shriners Children's. Running for the position where Imperial Sir James E, "Ed" Stolze Jr. and Dr. Leslie "Doc" Stewart, M.D., Leslie "Doc" Stewart won and he is the new Chairman of the Board of Trustees.

As I have reported before the growth for the Shrine is coming from International Temples, as depicted on the slide that I showed at the May meeting 11 of the 12 International Temples in Region 15 have received Gold or Platinum and we have created 13,949 Shriners Internationally since 2007. The Shrine as a whole had a 3.93% loss in 2023, which is the smallest percentage of loss in the last twenty years.




An emotional day in Sacramento




We were warmly welcomed by the staff of Shriners Childrens and were able to see some of the units in the hospital.
