Dear Nobles All,

The Hospital and Transportation teams have been very busy receiving and processing applications for new children as well as moving the current children under our care to and from Shriner Hospitals for Children (HSC). We have been working well with the team in Tampa and moving some things along. We have a lot of follow-ups, emails, and late phone calls with the team there and the result is the care and treatment of our children in the hospitals.

Over the past 2 years we have accomplished the following:

New patients' applications received: 10 from Turkey, 1 from Greece, 2 from Romania

Applications accepted by SHC: 12

Kids Moved to and from SHC: 3 (Zoi, Khalid, Safiya)

Kids travelling in the next 6-12 months: 4 confirmed (Dorka, Cristian, Bianca, Laurentiu)

Unfortunately, we had one potential patient that was not accepted. The doctors decided that the child was not eligible for care due to no need for surgical intervention at the time of application. In cases like this, the family has the opportunity to reapply for care in 6 months as the status of the child may change over time.

The Clown Unit has requested permission from the Potentate to attend the Cyprus Shriners Outreach Clinic in Cyprus from the 23rd to the 28th of October 2023. Here we will entertain the approximately 300 children and their families who will be treated and assessed these days. Permission from the Potentate to participate is currently pending.

During these days, a team of doctors from Shriners Children will come to Nicosia on Cyprus to carry out preliminary examinations and treat children from neighboring countries.

In recent years, around 300 children have been examined within a week. These children like to travel with one or two relatives. That means there are about 800 people spread over the week on site.

Since we as a clown unit do not normally have the great opportunity to organize something together, this is a very good opportunity to put a smile on the children's faces together as a clown unit.

Travel, accommodation, meals, and activities are at your own expense. If you want to take a few days' vacation with meaning, please let me know as soon as possible. Depending on how many of you are interested, imagine 2-3 hours of morning activities, 2-3 hours of afternoon activities. Activities can be anything from balloon animals, rock painting, playing games, face painting, etc. The challenge is that the children are usually not as mobile as others of the same age and that there can certainly be language challenges.

The activities should therefore be simple, universal, and of course child friendly. You don't necessarily have to take part in a full clown outfit: a red nose, a funny hat, that's usually enough. You don't have to do any skits either, it's more of a kind of play therapy and activity for the children while they're waiting - and this also relieves the parents/relatives. So rather play. However, if you can do tricks, you are of course very welcome.

Personally, we take a week off, find a cheap place to stay, entertain the kids during the day and cozy up with the nobles and ladies at night. Our current Imperial Potentate Imp. Sir Kenny Craven, and First Lady Jennifer have stated that they will also be present.

Formed as "an honorable drinking fraternity composed of ladies and gentlemen of the highest morals and good character, who are never vulgar," the Turtles quickly took flight to what would eventually spread throughout the VFW and American Legion posts. The Turtles even made their way into colleges and high schools throughout the United States following the war. Today, the Turtles can be found associated with some of the same organizations as well as Moose and Elk Clubs and various Masonic organizations like the Shriners.

Led by Turtle legends like Don Ellis and Greg Anderson, the Turtles have existed in our jurisdiction for a long time, however, have never officially consolidated with a unified purpose, mission, or vision. We are proud to say, all this changed on May 13, 2023, when the Emirat Pond, Ancient and Honorable Order of Turtles was officially chartered by Emirat Shriners with 34 Charter Members. Our Pond formed with similar idea to Captain McGowan, focusing on fun and fellowship while concentrating on a very important mission – raising funds for the Emirat Shriners Transportation Fund. We are officially a volunteer, unincorporated association formed for fraternal purposes and the promotion of good fellowship among the Turtles and members of Shriners International. Our motto remains unchanged because, "Turtles are bright eyed, bushy tailed, fearless, and unafraid folk with a fighter pilot attitude. They think clean, have fun a lot, and recognize the fact that you never get anyplace worthwhile in life unless you stick your neck out."



A SHRINER WORKING IN THE FIELD





On February 6, 2023, two major earthquakes hit Southeast Turkey within 9 hours.

11 provinces were affected by these earthquakes and over 51.000 people have lost their lives. This is the officially announced figure, but all evidence shows that the actual casualties are over 100 000!

13 million people were affected and left homeless, thousands of houses were destroyed, hundreds of thousands of people were injured -many of them being children under "18".

As Shriners we had to be active and help them as much as we can. Thus, as an Emirat Shriner Noble Refik Kutluer immediately started to work.

The most important task was to reach the severely injured and mainly amputated children under the age of 18. To enable this, an announcement was distributed through all possible network channels.

Noble Refik was able to reach over 30 amputated children and started to prepare their dossier for Shriners Hospitals Children. Daily communications with SHC and the families, all paperwork preparations continue, and 8 children will be sent to USA SHC very soon.

Sahra, 10 years old, female, fasciotomy is present in the right and left legs, whose %90 of the left leg will be lost, she has been accepted at Boston Shriner's Hospital.

Mehtez, 9 years old, male, his both legs are amputated, he has been accepted at Chicago Shriner's Hospital

Yakup, 13 years old, male, left leg is amputated, has graft on the right leg, He has been accepted at Boston Shriner's Hospital.

Cenk, 17 years old male, right arm is amputated.

Tolga, 16 years old male, both of his legs are amputated.

Bedirhan, 12 years old male, one of his legs is amputated and the other has fasciotomy.

İlayda, 17 years old female, has been saved after 80 hours, her right foot is amputated, and she has been accepted to Spokane Shriner's Hospital.

Deniz, 16 years old female, her both legs are amputated, She is accepted to Philadelphia Shriner's Hospital. Our beautiful 16-year-old Deniz, who was rescued from the rubble in Iskenderun, Hatay, has been a scholarship student at Iskenderun Private Bashkent Schools for 3 years. She has always been the joy of her class and school, and now she has become our new "Hera". She lost her father and brother in the earthquake. She and her mother were pulled out of the rubble after 52 hours. Both were taken directly to intensive care. Her mother's condition is relatively better, but unfortunately both of Deniz's legs had to be amputated above the knee. The reason we call Deniz "Hera" (The Mythological Woman God who is the symbol of strength) is because, for a 16-year-old who lost her father, brother, and feet, she stands so strong that she gives morale to others when we should be giving it to her.

THIS IS A TALE OF THE KELOGLAN "BALD BOY" SHRINER OF TURKEY



Is it a coincidence? Noble Refik had attended the Imperial Session in Minnesota USA last year and walked at the Parade dressing up as the Keloğlan (Bald Boy). Keloğlan is a well-known character in Turkish folklore. He is bald from birth, is a clever and lucky character. He represents the Anatolian people who can have big dreams, who are virtuous, prudent, a little bald, a little romantic and very active. He is a type representing the people with his positive and negative characteristics in the Turkish fairy tale narrative tradition. His main characteristics are his honesty, bravery, courage, benevolence, generosity, and cunningness. As the events unfold, he overcomes difficulties unexpectedly for his age and stature.

Likewise, Noble Refik Kutluer, as an Emirat Shriner, continues to work in the field by himself, - despite all obstacles, in close contact with III. Sir Paul and Shriner's International. Ambassador and the Deputy Chief of Mission of USA Embassy in Ankara are helping with the visa process for the children and their guardians.

Noble Refik Says: "The encouraging messages and grateful statements to the work I am doing are helping me to overcome all obstacles. I continue to work intensively for our mutual aim that is to be able to see a smile on the faces of these poor children, once again."

The number of earthquake victims, children to be sent to SHC may increase as there are hundreds (maybe thousands) of children waiting for our help, most of them being amputated.

The "Bald Boy" does not only represent the poor children who were severely injured and lost their limbs at the disastrous earthquake, but, also, it symbolically, represents the Turkish Shriner who works for them.
